At the BBCR our foremost concern is the integrity of the breeds we represent. One step we take to ensure accuracy in pedigree is under certain circumstances to ask for additional information on your dog and its ancestors. This simple supplemental information packet will guide you step by step thru the process to obtain BBCR registration on your Shortybull.

If the Shortybull you are presenting for registration does not have a verifiable pedigree or the breeder can not provide a accurate history of the your dog, the inspection process will be the determining factor. On a scale of 0 - 100 based solely off the breed standard developed by the original founders of the breed, you dog will be awarded "points" in a number of categories. Any dog that scores less than 85% when compared to the breed standard by evaluators will be denied for registration. Any dog that meets the standard to at least 85% but less than 100% will be classified as breeding stock and will not be eligible to enter conformation shows. In addition, the dogs offspring will be graded at 1 year (12 months) of age against the official standard for the breed. Any offspring meeting the standard will be permanently registered as a Shortybulls and will be eligible for all offered events. Any offspring still not meeting standard will be flagged in the system and be subjected to a standard evaluation on offspring. Although we never set out to turn an application down, there are certain situations that the difficult decision must be made to preserve the overall integrity of the breed.

If your dog is accepted you will receive your official BBCR certificate of registration. If there are any further questions or if it is found to be in the best interest of the breed to decline registration to individual dogs, you will be notified in writing and a official scoresheet will accompany this correspondence. Any questions will be addressed only by ownership or certified breed experts either by phone or email. Denial of registration is never the goal of the BBCR but it is a necessary reality at times. No matter the outcome we are here to help you thru the process and any questions that result.

BBCR Shortybull Supplemental Information Worksheet

1. **Pictures:** As we are unable to physically visit every Shortybull we register the visual presentation can tell us a lot about your dog. The pictures should be unaltered, un cropped, and of high quality. Please avoid tall grass, obstructing objects, thick collars, people or other animals. The pictures submitted will be evaluated by no less than three of our breed experts and findings will be returned to you in writing or you will receive your official BBCR permanent registration certificate. **Following pictures must be included:** Front picture standing nicely square to the camera. Side picture, standing on a level flat surface, square to the camera. Rear standing, level and well square. You are welcome to submit more than one of each view if you feel your pictures are not representative of the true presentation of your dog.
2. **Video:** We ask you submit a one minute vid. of your dog in a relaxed, natural state. Standing and moving should be the focus. Unaltered, un processed vid. is a requirement. This does not need to be High Def but should be good quality. (not required but the more information you present can work in your favor)
3. **Measurement Of Dog:** The breed standard has a clear and defined height limits, by using a canine wicket we are able to better understand the overall presentation of your dog. This must be preformed by a licensed veterinarian and detailed in the directions. Your vet must determine the official height of your dog and submit with official letterhead, license number and contact information.
4. **Weight:** All veterinarians have accurate scales in order to determine your pets weight for overall health as well as calculating medications and anesthesia. Taking your dog to you veterinarian for a official veterinary weight will be part of the process. Your vet must determine the official weight of your dog and submit with official letterhead, license number and contact information.
5. **Microchip:** In order to better track the breed, microchips are a valuable form of permanent identification. We ask microchip be placed and recorded by or minimally recored on the weight record by your veterinarian. It is advisable to check in advance which brands of microchip your veterinarian has the tools to read.
6. **DNA Profile:** We ask that you submit a complete DNA profile of your dog and where possible the sire and dam. This will be added to your permanent registration certificate. Using a certified DNA profiling company is required.
7. **Breeder/ Owner Statement Of Accuracy In Application:** Submitting your supplemental information packet makes a statement that you believe based on the information you have a available, your dog is a true

Shortybull we ask that you sign the owner/ breeder statement and return it along with the packet as your personal statement of reporting.
